

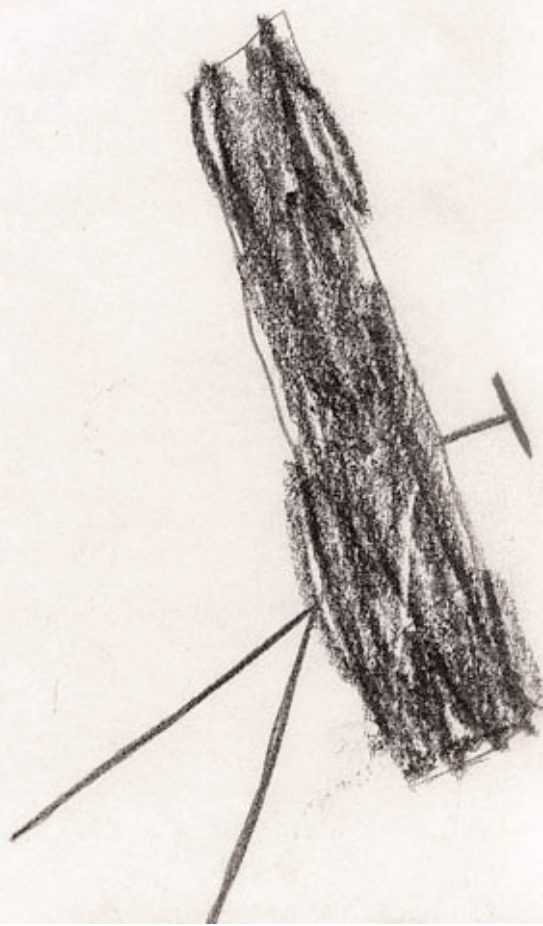

far away.



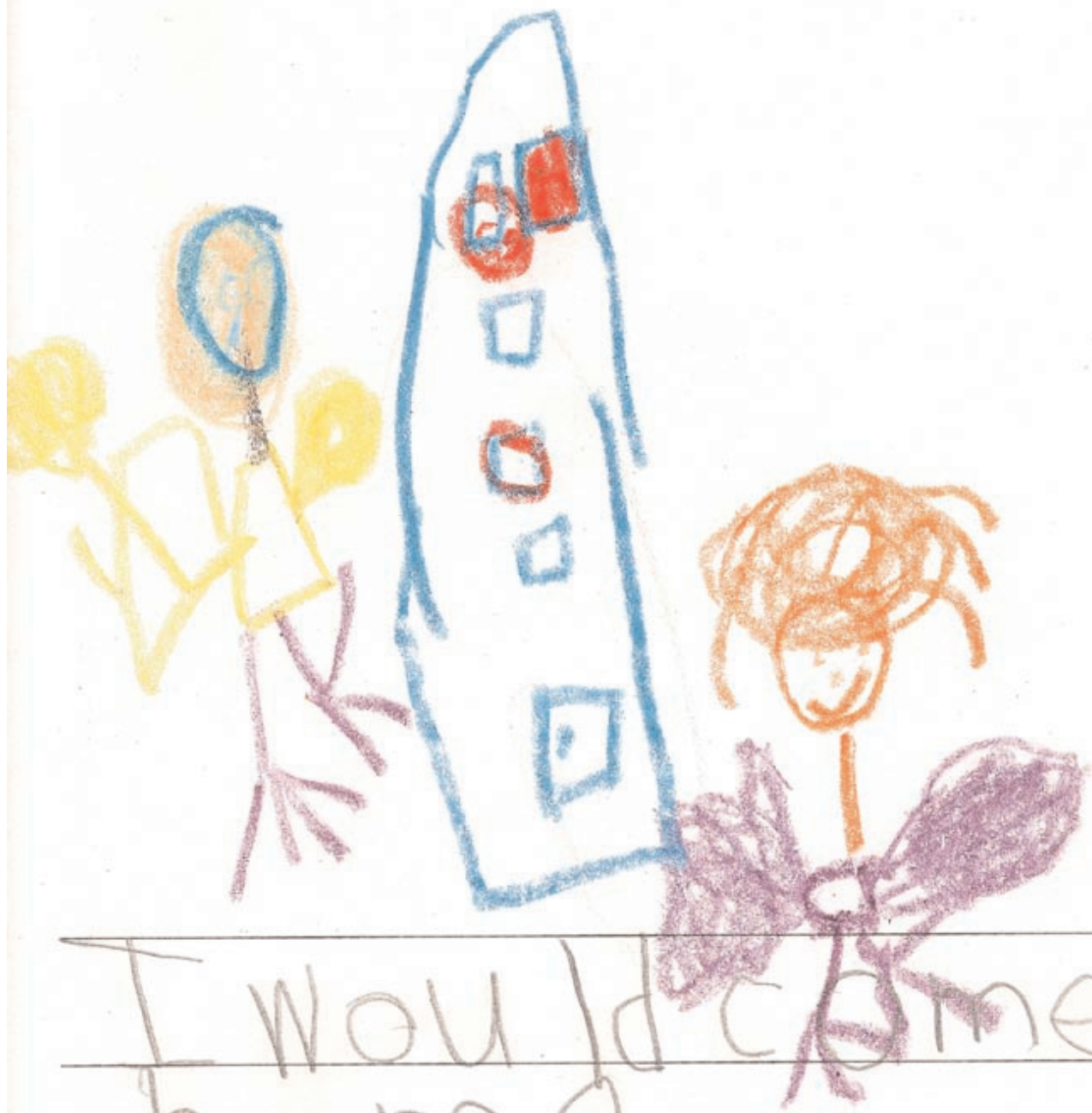
The stars are
